

Beautec for Spas® FAQ and Answers

- 1. What is the best way to use the Beautec for Spas? Add the product monthly for best results.
- 2. <u>Can I use the spa after adding Beautec® for Spas</u>? Yes, the treated water is perfectly safe for bathers to use.
- 3. <u>Is Beautec® for Spas acidic</u>? *Beautec® is non-hazardous and non-acidic. It is safe for all type of spa finishes and equipment.*
- 4. If I am using Beautec*, do I still need to use a metal control product to control staining? In most cases you do not need a metal sequestering agent unless you have very high metal issues.
- 5. <u>Will Beautec* for Spas remove calcium buildup on my spa surfaces and tile?</u> Yes. Follow label directions for best results.
- 6. <u>Does Beautec* for Spas remove or just control scum line buildup</u>? *Actually, it does both effectively. The product functions continuously to clean all spa surfaces, filter, heat exchanger, decorative tile, plumbing, salt cells and measuring probes as well.*
- 7. Will Beautec® for Spas just prevent calcium buildup on my salt cell or will it also remove existing calcium scale? Actually, it both prevents and calcium de-scaling unless the salt cell is extremely scaled.
- 8. <u>Do I need to purchase a "purging" product to clean spa water recirculating lines when using Beautec® for Spas?</u> It is not necessary to purchase a separate product as Beautec® for Spas continuously cleans spa water pipes and plumbing.
