

Pooltec Fall-Winter® FAQ and Answers

- 1. <u>What is the best way to use the product</u>? Add product at pool closing when water temperature has dropped below 70 degrees for best results. In the sun belt states, it is best to wait until October or November. In the snow belt states, it is fine to add in September weather permitting.
- Is it necessary to add chlorine when using Pooltec Fall-Winter
 Treatment?
 If the pool is clean and free from algae growths, it is not necessary.
 However, chlorine shocking the pool is a good practice especially for mesh or safety covered pools. It is also recommended if the outside weather is still warm.
- 3. <u>What else should be done when closing the pool in the fall</u>? Follow normal pool closing procedure especially in snow belt regions when using Pooltec Fall-Winter[®] treatment.
- 4. <u>Is it necessary to balance pool water chemistries before closing the pool</u> <u>with Pooltec Fall-Winter</u> *Yes for best results.*
- 5. <u>Should I double the treatment dosage for Pooltec Fall-Winter</u> treatment for <u>mesh and safety covered pools</u>? Yes, because these types of pools are still open to the atmosphere and could develop algae growths in the spring if not enough treatment is present.
- 6. <u>Is Pooltec Fall-Winter® Treatment effected by heat, sunlight and</u> <u>evaporation</u>? No. The treatment should last at least 4 to 6 months if proper dosage is added.
- 7. <u>Can you over treat with Pooltec Fall-Winter® Treatment</u>? In most cases, over treatment is not harmful.
- 8. <u>If the pool has existing algae, what should be done before starting</u> <u>treatment</u>? *The pool must be treated to remove all algae so the treatment is started with a clean pool*
