



- 1. What is the best way to use the Spatec®? Add weekly for best results and follow label dosage directions.
- 2. <u>Can you use Spatec®</u> with bromine or chlorine? Yes. Spatec® has a strong synergy with bromine and chlorine which helps to improve sanitation and water clarity. This powerful synergy allows users to use up to 50% sanitizer which also helps make the spa water feel more comfortable to bathers.
- 3. <u>Is Spatec® EPA registered</u>. *Yes. It is classified as an algaecide but the product is also a broad-spectrum bactericide.*
- 4. <u>Is Spatec® a water clarifier</u>? Spatec® clarifies spa water do to its unique and highly effective flocculation (clarification) of spa water particles to create ultra-clear water.
- 5. <u>Do I need to use a phosphate remover when using Spatec</u>. ? No need to use a phosphate remover as Spatec both kills and prevents algae growths.

  <u>Note</u>: phosphate removers have not yet been proven to prevent algae growth; although they are a component of fertilizers, it is nitrogen that causes algae to grow.
- 6. <u>I added Spatec®</u> and <u>Beautec®</u> for Spas together and the spa water turned hazy and cloudy, please explain what is going on? Although both products should be added separately on different days, this is a normal reaction. The spa water will again turn clear in a day or two but the spa can be used immediately.
